Communication/ Literacy

- Collect a leaflet from somewhere you visit and bring it to school to share with the class.
- Identify or read signs and notices while out and about.
- Write a list or note/ letter to someone.

Maths:

- Exchange coins and banknotes in shops or use a card device to pay.
- Help to calculate how much the shopping will cost (use a calculator/mobile to help).
- Calculate how much change is required if paying by cash.

Wider Curriculum

- Look for Health and Safety signs when out in the community.
- Take part in a sport e.g. a run, swimming, tennis.
- Plant some bulbs or seeds and care for them.
